

In light of concerns surrounding COVID-19 virus, the BBPUD wants to reassure our customers that your drinking water is safe and that we continue to operate under normal treatment plant operations. As part of our treatment process we disinfect the treated water by chlorination, a process that is designed to kill pathogens, including viruses and bacteria. Currently there is no evidence that the COVID-19 virus survives the disinfection process. The District continues to perform all required monitoring and sampling required by the State Water Resource Control Board.

We do realize and encourage the importance to clean surfaces with disinfectant products, including wipes, to reduce the spread of COVID-19. It is important to dispose of those items in the trash, not the toilet.

Please do not flush disinfectant wipes or paper towels down the toilet.
