NATURAL HAZARD PLANNING AND PREPAREDNESS



BBPUD is participating in the **2026 Sonoma County Hazard Mitigation Plan** to better prepare for natural disasters and participate in creating a resilient community. Bodega Bay is vulnerable to several types of natural hazards, including wildfire, earthquake, tsunami, landslides, flooding and drought.



The outcome of this planning process is to identify projects that would measurably reduce the community's vulnerability to damage by building resiliency in our water and wastewater infrastructure. Participation in these efforts will also qualify BBPUD for federal grants that could fund some of these improvements.
